### CURRICULUM VITAE

Laura Macchi is full professor of Psychology of Thinking and Decision Making and she is Coordinator of the Ph.D. in Psychology at the Department of Psychology - University of the Studies Milano-Bicocca in Milano (Italy). She carried out experimental studies about probabilistic reasoning and decision-making, insight problem solving, and pragmatics. She developed, in collaboration with M. Bagassi and G. Mosconi, a *pragmatic approach* to the study of thinking in numerous articles and in her 2003 book "Thinking: Psychological Perspectives on Reasoning, Judgment and Decision Making" (in collaboration with D.J. Hardman). She was co-editor of a special issue on "Dual Process theories of human thought: the debate" (*Mind and Society*, 2012), and of a special issue on "Insight and Creative Problem Solving" (*Thinking & Reasoning*, 2013), and she is co-editor of the book "Human rationality. Thinking thanks to constraints", in preparation for MIT Press.
